In this assignment you are going to conduct some research into the range of work undertaken by three contrasting Services in the Public Sector.

TASK

Create a **Poster** which outlines the range of work **undertaken in x3 contrasting Public Services**.

Your **poster** should cover the following:

- **The overall aims of the x3 organisations**
- **At least x3 roles that exist within each organisation**
- **A comparison of the work undertaken by the three Services-both similarities and differences.**
- **Pictures that show the job being undertaken.**

Example: Service- British Army- **Aim-** (state overall aim of the Army), **X3 Roles that exist** within the Army- Combat Medical Technician, Infantry Soldier & Royal Military Police Officer- (state for each role work undertaken). **Comparison-** If we had chosen Army, RAF and Police then we would do at least two similarities and differences for the below comparisons:

Similarities- Army & RAF- e.g. Both require individuals to continuously maintain high fitness standards to ensure they can undertake their role.	Similarities- Army & Police	Similarities- RAF & Police
Differences- Army & RAF	Differences- Army & Police	Differences- Police & RAF

TASK

Create an **academic poster** which explores different career pathways, the associated job opportunities and their requirements in the Uniformed Protective Services. You will pick one Service which you are interested in or is the organisation of your desired career path.

Your **academic poster** will include:

- The scope and provision of Uniformed Protective Service careers (number of jobs available in organisation, provisions available locally and nationally, factors that affect the Service's provision and employment opportunities and amount of people provide the Service for).
- Careers and jobs in the Uniformed Protective Services (Job roles and career opportunities available in the Service, Employers, Types of employment- full- time/ reserve, key pathways- i.e. pathways within a career in the Service e.g. Police Officer for 18 months then apply to train to become part of the Tactical Aid Unit).
- What requirements are needed in order to be able to access that career? (Background checks, Passing probation, Fitness tests, Medical tests etc.).
- Professional training routes in the Uniformed Protective Services (e.g. Apprenticeships, Internal progression, Graduate Schemes, University degrees etc.).
- What development opportunities are available? (e.g. promotions, qualifications, courses, training, membership to professional bodies).
