# WHERE COULD THIS COURSE TAKE YOU?

## Level 1 Beauty Therapy

The Beauty Therapy course is a starter course into your chosen career pathway. You would be performing basic manicures, skincare routines, makeup applications and nail art designs.

This would give you the opportunity to work in a salon, developing your experience in client care, maintaining hygiene, basic reception duties and observing and supporting other therapists in the workplace performing their treatments.

## Level 2 Beauty Therapy

Beauty Therapy would be the next building block in your career pathway, where you would develop existing skills and knowledge from your previous Level 1 course.

You will be performing luxury manicures and pedicures, hot and warm waxing techniques, extending your facial routine, tan applications, eye treatment services like tinting and individual lash applications and designing creative makeup and nail art appearances. You would also be participating in an open salon where you would perform treatments on external clients and develop your confidence to support you with your work experience.

You will be working in a salon (60 hours of work experience required) located in a location convenient to yourself where you would gain further salon experience and set up working stations, perform Level 2 beauty treatments and develop your reception duties.

### Level 3 Beauty Therapy

Level 3 Beauty Therapy would be your final year of studying before you become a fully qualified beauty therapist. You would extend your practical skills into full body massage (Swedish and aromatherapy) massage, hot and cold stones therapy massage, and body and facial electricals.

Again you are required to gain 60 hours of work experience in a salon/spa where you would be performing all level 2 beauty treatments and developing your level 3 procedures, along with maintaining your client's care skills and promoting/selling additional services and products.

These qualifications will direct you into an exciting career path of your choosing such as a, salon, spa, cruise ship, working abroad, self-employed, setting up your own business or moving on to your Level 4 Beauty Therapy.

### **UNIFORM & KIT**

You will be given order forms on the day of enrolment where you will then order these online. These forms will detail the costings and payment methods.

These kits and uniforms will be delivered to your home and must be ordered at enrolment, before starting your course. You will need to purchase footwear, which must be all-black, closed-toed; without any signage or branding.

This is part of your uniform dress code and must be worn at all times, along with your hair up when in the salon area. If you need support buying your kit, you can complete a support fund form, which will be provided at enrolment.

# A TASK TO GET YOU STARTED..

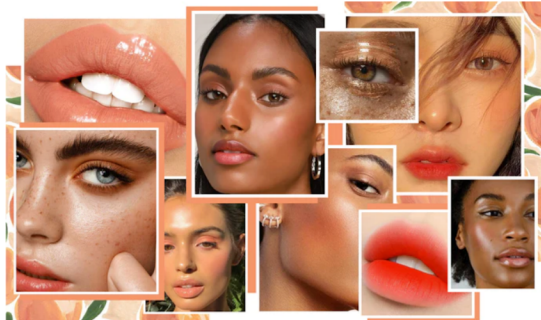
Create a mood board about an area of Beauty Therapy that interests you, for example, make-up, nails, body treatments etc...
