Subsidised Bus Service

As part of Macclesfield College's Transport Plan, which aims to reduce traffic volume, the College provides a subsidised bus service for full-time 16-18 year old students.

The following services are available depending on where you live:

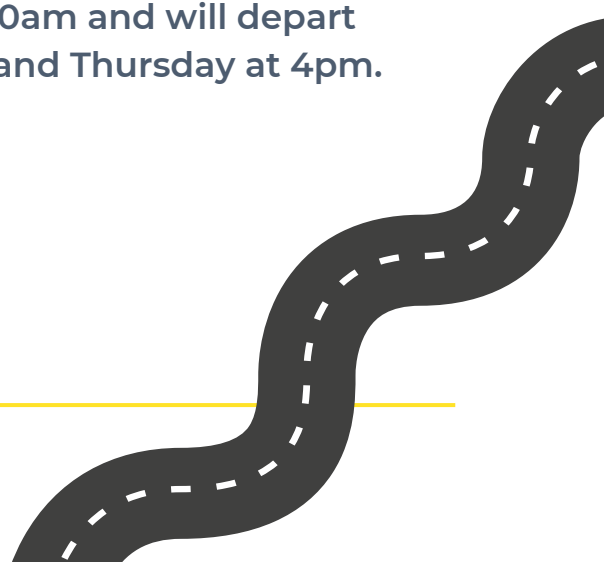

Please note that where a contract service exists for your home area, this is the only service that the College will subsidise for you.

No support is provided for students living within 3 miles of the College.

All transport information is correct for September 2025, however, routes and pick up points may be reassessed at any time for operational and efficiency requirements.

All services are timetabled to arrive before 9.00am and will depart Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday at 4.40pm and Thursday at 4pm.



Help with Travel Costs

Students can choose to travel by public transport if there is no College service provided, e.g. Manchester or Sandbach.

Students will need to apply for the Financial assistance if you qualify for support with these costs. Students will be reimbursed their travel costs on a monthly basis (tickets or petrol costs based on mileage).

Please note that this support is means tested. The following restrictions apply to this assistance:

- Students who are eligible to travel on college buses but choose not to, will not be supported.
- No support is provided for students living within 3 miles of the College.
- Reimbursement is affected by attendance and students must maintain a minimum of 90% attendance to all aspects of the study programme.
- Taxi fares are not reimbursed.
- Charges incurred for parking e.g. permits or tickets from Macclesfield Bus or Train station to the College will not be reimbursed.

Students are expected to purchase tickets in advance direct from the operator, and seek the most cost-effective travel to them. Discount passes are recommended, but will not be reimbursed by the College e.g. Our Pass or Student Railcard

Application links will be sent to students who have completed their enrolment preparation form over the summer.

Full details of how to claim assistance will be all detailed when applying for financial assistance.

Other Support

If you do not qualify for travel support as you do not qualify for financial assistance or you live within the three mile radius, D&G and other local bus companies do have payment plans/monthly travel passes for students available.

Further information about local transport in the area can be found on the local council website.

If your child requires travel assistance, you will need to speak to your Local Authority to arrange this.

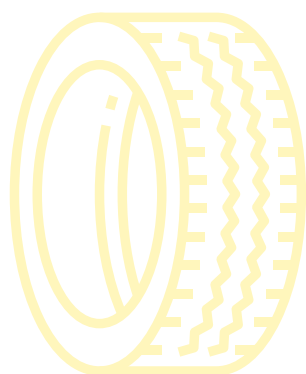

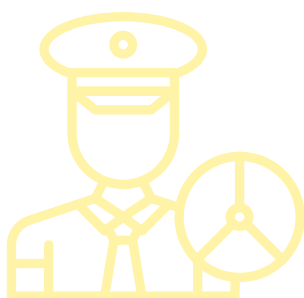

Travelling by Car

If you're planning to drive to college, either daily or as a one off visit, here's everything you need to know.

Student Parking

We operate a ParkingEye system across our campus car parks. The good news? Parking is completely free for students. To avoid receiving a penalty charge, you must register your vehicle registration number with the college. Once registered, you're good to go, no need to sign in each time. If you change cars, don't forget to update your details.

Visitor Parking

Visitors are also welcome to use the car park. However, their vehicle must be registered at Reception within 30 minutes of arrival. This is a quick process and helps avoid any accidental fines. Top Tip: Always double check your number plate is entered correctly, ParkingEye doesn't forgive typos!



Other Transport

Macclesfield College is well connected by both bus and rail, making it easy to get here without needing a car.

By Bus

The college is just a short walk from Macclesfield Bus Station, with regular services from surrounding towns and villages including Congleton, Leek, Wilmslow and Knutsford.

By Train

We're also very close to Macclesfield Railway Station, just a 10-15 minute walk.

Cycling to College

Prefer two wheels? Brilliant! We have secure bike racks on campus for students and staff. Lock your bike safely and you're good to go.



Good to Know:
Students can often get discounts on train travel and Railcards, it's worth checking online before booking to make sure you're getting the best deal. Popular places to look include Student Beans, UNiDAYS, TOTUM, and ticket sites like Trainline.

FAQ'S

We've compiled some of our FAQs below, which will help with any questions you might have.

When will my bus pass be issued?

Your bus pass will be included with your student ID badge during your first week.

What if I lose my pass?

If you lose your student ID badge (which also holds your bus pass), there will be a £5 replacement charge.

I've withdrawn from my course. Can I get a refund on my bus pass?

Refunds depend on the time of year. You may be eligible for a full or partial refund. Please contact the Finance Office for more information.

Can I take a friend home with me?

The pass is issued for your use only. It can't be used for additional passengers.

Are buses running on induction week?

All buses will operate from the 1st September and you will be able to travel without lanyard for the first week.

How does the bus pass work?

Your bus pass is linked to your student ID badge, so make sure to keep it safe!

What happens if it snows?

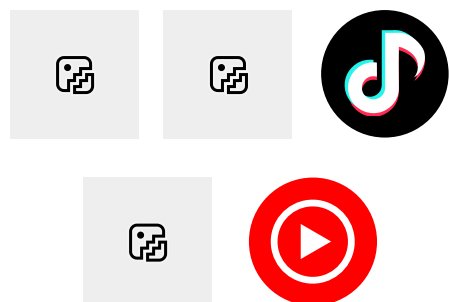
